



HOUSE MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY ¹

1. House Membership, confers the privilege of using the dining room, pro shop, and tennis shop. House members may use the club's sport facilities (golf, tennis, pool, and platform tennis) on a restricted basis (see 8, 9, 10, below).
2. House Members are not voting members of the Club, but are entitled to be present at any meeting of the Regular Members.
3. All applicants for Regular Membership must accept House Membership while awaiting an opening in Regular Membership.
4. The approval of the Board of Governors is required to change a membership from House Membership to Regular Membership.
5. House members are welcome to host their guests to the dining room, without limitation.
6. The number of House Memberships is presently limited to sixty.
7. Children of House Members under the age of twenty-five have the same privileges as their parents, subject to certain restrictions listed in the By-Laws.
8. House Members may use each of the Club's sports facilities once each calendar month, with the payment of a daily use fee. The sport facilities comprise the golf course, tennis courts, swimming pool, and platform tennis courts.
9. House Members may use sports facilities once per month as guests of Regular Members, who are subject to guest fees for each such use, e.g. \$30 greens fee.
