

Summary of Fees, Dues and Assessments

1. Golf

- a. Daily use and guest fee:
 - i. Playing with member:
 - 1. nine holes: \$15
 - 2. eighteen holes: \$30
 - ii. Playing without member:
 - 1. nine holes: \$30
 - 2. eighteen holes: \$60
- b. Cart rental:
 - i. Nine holes: \$9
 - ii. Eighteen holes: \$18
 - iii. 4-Bagger \$12.00 per person
 - iv. 3-Bagger \$15.00 per person
- c. Locker: \$50
- d. Private lessons: on request
- e. Jr. Program \$40 per week
- f. Mom's Clinic \$30

2. Tennis

- a. Daily use and guest fee:
 - i. Adult: \$10
 - ii. Child: \$5
- b. Private lessons with Kenyon Clark: \$75 per hr; \$30 per person for two person semi-private lesson
- c. Clinics: Price determined by number of people participating
- d. Junior Summer Program: \$50 per week: 3 days of 1 hour clinic play, 1 day of organized ladder match play and 1 day of interclub
- e. Advanced Junior Program: \$70 per wee, 3 days of 1-1/2 hour clinic play, 1 day of organized ladder match play and 1 day of interclub
- f. Pee Wee \$12 per day
- g. League and Doubles Nights: \$2.00 Ball Charge

3. Pool

- a. Daily use and guest fee:
 - i. Adult: \$10
 - ii. Child: \$10
 - b. Private lessons: on request
 - c. Pool rental for private parties (see Article 2, Paragraph 24): on request
4. Platform Tennis
- a. Daily use and guest fee: \$10 per person
5. Membership
- a. Initiation Fee
 - i. House: One time initiation fee of \$5,000.00
 - ii. Regular: One Time initiation fee of \$12,000.00
 - b. Annual Dues
 - i. Senior Regular and House: \$950 (pro-rated to number of months remaining in the year if after June 30), plus \$55 monthly assessment and a capital assessment of \$20 per month.
 - ii. Senior House: \$475 plus \$27.50 monthly assessment and a capital assessment of \$10 per month.
 - iii. Regular: \$2600 pro-rated to number of months remaining in the year if after June 30), plus \$110 monthly assessment, and for 2009, a capital assessment of \$40 monthly
 - iv. House members who become regular members after June 30 pay dues based on the remaining months in the year.
 - v. Senior Members who became Senior Members prior to January 1, 2010 must notify the Board of governors by December 31, 2010 which class of Senior Membership they wish to become as of January 1, 2011.
 - c. Food and Beverage Minimum: For the period, January 1 – June 30, \$400 for Regular and House members and \$200 for Senior Regular and Senior House Members. For the period, July 1 – December 31, \$600 for Regular and House members and \$300 for Senior Regular and Senior House Members. Takeout orders and catered events may be used to satisfy these minimums. If a member resigns, they will be charged a pro rata amount of their unused Food and Beverage Minimum. For example, if someone resigns on October 1, they will be responsible for the balance of their unused minimum, in this case, \$300 (1/2 of \$600).
